## Knights Chaplain's Message



Dear Knights and Columbiettes,

On February 23rd, I watched a brave man die. Poughkeepsie Police Officer John Falcone had responded to a call near the City Train Station. He took part in rescuing a child from the hands of the child's father, who had allegedly just killed the child's mother. Then the officer was shot critically and the perpetrator killed himself. Terribly, terribly tragic!

At six o'clock that evening I was called to Officer Falcone's bedside, Room #1 in the Intensive Care Unit at Vassar Hospital. He was obviously very critically ill. I did what priests do: with all the faith in me, I absolved him of his sins, I anointed him with the holy oil, I granted him a plenary indulgence, and I prayed that the angels and saints would surround him and pray for him. In a small waiting room I spoke with and prayed with his down-to-earth, good parents, John and Margaret. A while later, his father asked me to pray with him at his son's side. I did. And not long afterwards, with John's family and friends squeezed into the room, we prayed the prayers of the dying. There was silence and even peace. We commended this heroic officer to the Lord. We asked Mary, the angels and the saints to accompany him to the Father's House, to the place that Jesus had prepared for him. And when death had come, I watched the moving moments when his sister, and then his father and mother, and then a friend bent down and kissed him one last time on his forehead. John would bear their love and the love of so many others into eternity.

Two other things more I vividly remember. The nurses, Marie and Karen, worked tirelessly at his side, trying to keep John's air passages open. At one point a supervisor arrived, indicated that the nurses had long passed their time on duty, and asked if they wanted to be relieved. Their spontaneous answer was, "No! We're here as long as we're needed." And when the supervisor has left, Marie added: "She doesn't know that my husband is a police officer too!"

The second thing. When John's brain had stopped functioning and he had stopped breathing, he was pronounced dead. But we all noted that his heart was still beating. The nurse explained that he had a strong heart and that it would beat some minutes more. It did and then it stopped. It reminded me that John had a heart that beat with love for others, even beyond death. It reminded me of Jesus' heart on the cross; even after He had died, a spear pierced it; His heart, the sign of His extraordinary love!

In May we commemorate Memorial Day, remembering those who have given their lives for the service of others. My patriotic brothers and sisters, remember in prayer all the honored dead of the Armed Services and all who like Detective John Falcone, who in service closer to home, have given their lives in loving service to all of us. Pray also for all the living who heroically and lovingly serve us today. Hearts beating with love!

God bless and protect all of you!

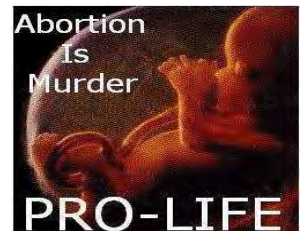

#### **ARTICLE VIII -- Funerals. Etc.**

Sec. 2. When notice of the death of a member in good standing is received, the Memorial Committee shall forward to the family of the deceased a message of condolence on behalf of the Council ***and the Memorial Committee shall arrange to have five Masses said for the repose of the soul of the deceased.***
