

CHAPLAIN'S MESSAGE

My Brother Knights,

This year, Easter seems to be so early as it is still in the month of March. My prayer has been that we avoid snow on the weekends of Palm Sunday and Easter so that all of our parishioners are able to attend Mass. At Christmas time, this year, Bishop Colacicco sent to the priests a prayer card for us to pray.... encouraging our parishioners to return to Sunday Mass. I am happy to say that I have been reciting this prayer for several months and have slowly started to see some returning faces.

This Lent has been a special time for parishes as they have individuals who are longing to return to the Sacraments, and or desiring to enter the faith through our RCIA programs. Their enthusiasm is truly inspiring. Easter is a time for a renewal of our own faith and the way in which we express our faith in the words we speak and in the very way in which we live our lives.

PRO - LIFE

On 3/19, feast of St. Joseph, NBC Nightly News reported the use of Mifeprex (Mifepristone), aka "medication abortion" has soared since Roe v Wade was overturned. The Supreme Court is preparing to hear another case that could limit access to it.

According to Gutmacher Institute (<u>gutmacher.org</u>) a new study shows that there were more than 1 Million abortions last year in the US.

"New data from the Monthly Abortion Provision Study show that use of medication abortion in the formal US health care system rose from 53% of all abortions in 2020 to 63% in 2023. The latest research also includes national and state-level abortion data for all of 2023, the first full year following the overturning of Roe v. Wade."

According to Dr. Cherise Felix, affiliated with Miami Planned Parenthood, women are able to schedule their abortion around their job and family obligations. The FDA has approved use of Mifeprex up to 10 weeks of pregnancy. Providers can proscribe it via tele-health and it can be sent by mail. So without traveling to a doctor's office, women seeking an abortion can receive the medication abortion drug in their mail. That's how Ellen Gallagher, CEO and Podcast host, used it. "It arrived in my mailbox. It was up to me when and if I wanted to take it... It removed so many barriers."

Dr. Felix: "Most women are finding out they are pregnant around 7 weeks."

The FDA in 2021 authorized mail-order medication abortion drugs without any screening.

When NBC correspondent, Dasha Burns, asked lawyer, Erik Baptist, who is proposing new limits on the FDA to the Supreme Court, what he plans to say. He replied: "I plan to explain how the FDA has unlawfully, and recklessly removed common sense safeguards for women who take abortion drugs.

The case, which the Supreme Court is considering, would restrict mailing of Mifeprex, require that the drug be provided in person at a doctor's office, and restrict its use up to 7 weeks.

Please pray that the Supreme Court will move to restrict the FDA from enabling medication abortion which is currently being used to thwart abortion restrictions throughout the US.
